# Lansing Track Invitational April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022

**ENTRY FEES:** Entry fees are \$60.00 for boys and girls, or \$120 for both. Entry fee checks should be made payable to: **Lansing High School** and may be mailed to the high school or delivered when you arrive to the meet.

<u>SCHOOLS COMPETING:</u> Emporia, FL Schlagle, KC Christian, Lansing, Leavenworth, Manhattan, Maranatha Academy, Ottawa, Seaman, Shawnee Heights, Shawnee Mission West, Topeka Hayden, Topeka West

## STARTER: Dan Dryer

**ENTRIES:** Each school may enter three (3) individuals in each event with the exception of the 1600 and 3200. Each School may enter Five (5) for the 1600 and 3200 M Race. An individual may be entered in a maximum of four events.

# **<u>REGISTRATION</u>**: Events will be seeded by the times you submit in with the entries. (NOTE-As soon as we have registration info you will receive it.)

**<u>COACHES MEETING</u>**: Scratches and substitutions meeting will occur at **2:30 pm**. No additions will be accepted.

<u>HIP NUMBERS -</u> Since Fully Automated Timing is being used, all athletes must wear hip and/or Chest stick on numbers during the running events. Please tell the running athletes that they must check in to the clerk station to get their hip numbers <u>thirty minutes prior</u> to their event. It is the athlete's responsibility to show up and get their number prior to their event. They will not be called.

Field Event athletes should check in at their event by showing up and giving their name to the event leader.

**SCORING:** Team scoring will be 10-8-6-4-2-1 in all events. Six places will be scored in each event.

**AWARDS:** First and second place team trophies will be awarded in both girls and boys divisions. Medals will be awarded to the first three places in all individual events and in the relays.

**PRELIMINARIES AND TRIALS:** All races will be finals against time. There are NO Prelims.

In the shot, discus, long jump, triple jump, and javelin, each entry will be given four tries with no finals. The "four alive" method will be used in the high jump and pole vault. The high jump will start at 5'6" (boys), 4'6" (girls) and go up 2" at a time. The pole vault will start at 9'6" (boys), 7'6" (girls) and go up 6" at a time.

**SURFACES:** Our track is rubber (1/8" spikes are required). Our discus and shot put surfaces are concrete. All runways for field events are rubberized, this includes the javelin.

NO SPIKES are to be worn in the bleachers. Only participants and coaches are allowed on the infield.

## **MISCELLANEOUS INFORMATION:**

- 1. Athletes must check in to get hip numbers 30 minutes prior to their running event.
- 2. Hip Numbers will be worn on Left hip and on the chest as well during the 1600 and 3200
- 3. Heat sheets, etc., can be picked up at the Finish Line.
- 4. We will furnish starting blocks.
- 5. KSHSAA rules and regulations will govern the meet.
- 6. Our start and finish line for lap races are on the first curve.
- 7. We will use a three-turn stagger in the 1600M relay.
- 8. The 300 meter intermediate hurdles and the 300 meter low hurdles will be run around on turn and will finish at the main finish line. The 300 meter intermediate and 300 meter low hurdles will be run against time as a final (No Preliminaries).
- 9. Parking for buses is located just west and north of the track.
